

Option 1: Using hangar bolt with t-nuts or mounting plates

- 1. Pre-drill hole in the bun foot slightly smaller then hanger bolt.
- 2. Start threading into bun foot by hand.
- 3. Thread two nuts on the machine threaded end.



4. Use a wrench or socket to fully seat wood threads into bun foot.



5. Choosing your mounting preference:

T-nut:

Drill hole to accommodate T-Nut. Then, pound it into hole with spikes toward the wood.



Mounting Plate:

Screw plate into furniture.



6. Mounting your bun foot:

T-Nut Mount: Mounting Plate Mount:






Bun Foot Installation

Option 2: Using Screws

*Use a minimum of 3 screws, no smaller than #8 x 2" long.

- 1. Pre-drill the screw holes.
- 2. Drive screws through the cabinet into the bun foot.
