



Measuring for Locating Holes for Corbels and Brackets at Desired Height

- 1. Determine desired height from floor to top of shelf. Example: 65"
- 2. Subtract thickness of shelf. Example: .75"
- 3. Subtract the distance from the top of the corbel to the top of the key. Example: .938 upper
- 4. Measure down to the top of the bottom key. Example: 3.625"
- 5. Screw into the wall making sure to stay perpendicular to the wall. Leave .25" revealed to slip the corbel into.
- 6. Slip corbel onto screw then push corbel down until it engages the narrow section of key, making sure it's completely seated.
