



## POWDER COATED METAL FINISHES

- ♦ For most powder-coated finishes, they are very durable in multiple ways, but like any finish, can be damaged if not treated or handled properly.
- ♦ Non-metallic powders like our matte black:
  - Durable against scratching, but can show light scratches if something metal scrapes them.
  - Durable outdoors, can last for years against weathering
  - Can chip if something metal or hard hits the finish just right
  - Not recommended as a commercial table top coating
  - Can be clear coated for extra durability and protection
- ♦ Powdered finishes that have hand-brushed applications like our oil rubbed bronze:
  - Durable against scratching, but can show light scratches if something metal scrapes them.
  - Durable outdoors if clear coated, can last for years against weathering
  - Can chip if something metal or hard hits the finish just right
  - Not recommended as a commercial table top coating
  - Can be clear coated for extra durability and protection
  - Constant rubbing against can cause the hand brushed finish to rub off if not clear coated
- ♦ Metallic powders like our gold and gun metal grey:
  - Durable against scratching, but can show light scratches if something metal scrapes them.
  - Durable outdoors if clear coated, can last for years against weathering
  - Can chip if something metal or hard hits the finish just right
  - Not recommended as a commercial table top coating
  - Clear coated recommend for commercial applications where wear and abrasion could be high
  - Can scuff is something is constantly rubbing against the finish
